

# Scrap Saver 18" Stylish Doll Tote Pattern

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Let's hit the town carrying a new stylish tote.  
Pattern includes fully reversible Classic Tote  
and two embellished versions.  
Please read through all steps before beginning.

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## Materials List

### Classic Tote:

Main Body-8"x12" scrap  
Lining-8"x12" scrap  
Handles- 9.5" of 5/8" ribbon x2

### Ruffle Tote:

Main Body-8"x12" scrap  
Lining-8"x12" scrap  
Ruffles-1.25"x12.5" strips x3  
Handles- 9.5" of 5/8" ribbon x2

### Big Flower Tote:

Main Body-8"x12" scrap  
Lining-8"x12" scrap  
Big Flower-1.25"x44" strip  
Handles- 9.5" of 5/8" ribbon x2  
Hot Glue Gun

**ALL SEAMS ARE 1/4" UNLESS STATED OTHERWISE**



1 Inch Test Square-This square should measure 1 inch when printed. Print pattern pieces with **NO** margins.

# Sewing Directions

## For all totes:

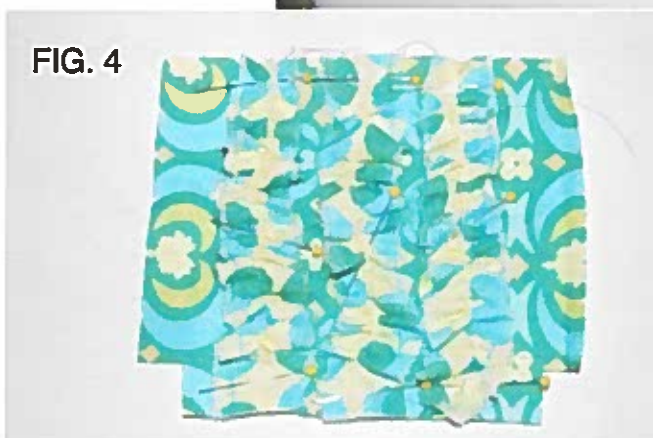
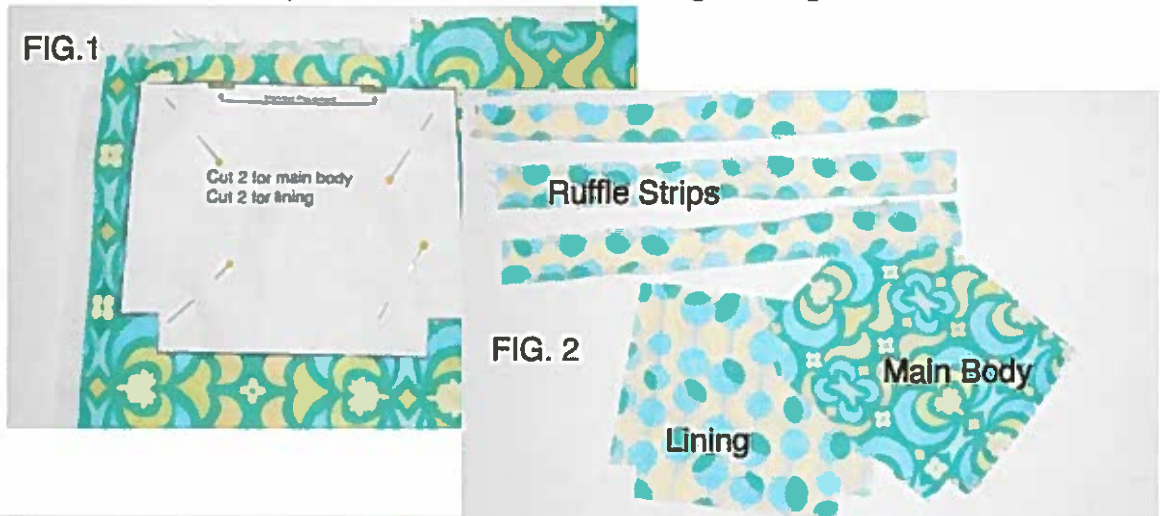
Step 1: Print off pattern and cut out all pieces needed. Mark for handles. For the strips used in the ruffle tote and big flower tote, I ripped those on the selvage of my fabric and left the edges unfinished to give it a shabby chic look.

Step 2: **For Ruffle tote-** We will work the front panel of this tote first. Run a gathering stitch down the center of each ruffle strip.

Step 3: Pin each strip to the bottom edge of front panel, spacing 1/4" apart ( FIG. 3)

Step 4: Gather each ruffle down and pin in place.( FIG. 4)

Step 5: Stitch down center of each ruffle to secure. And front panel of ruffle tote is completed. (FIG.5)



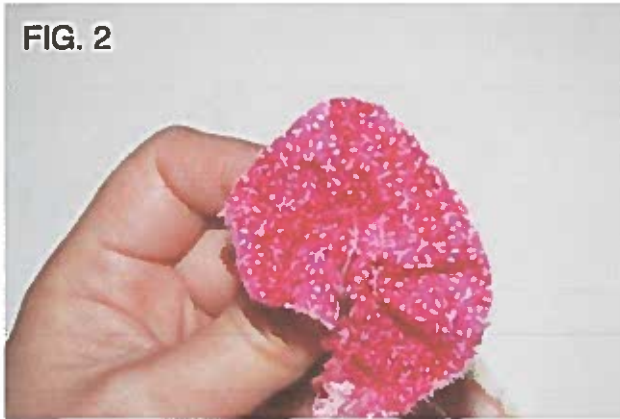
**Step 1: Big Flower Tote-** We will work the front panel of this tote first.

Run a gathering stitch down one edge of the flower strip using 1/4" allowance.

**Step 2:** Tie one end of threads in knot and gather strip until it measures 22". Knot ends.

**Step 3:** Now bunch a small portion in your fingers for center of flower (FIG. 2)  
Hot glue to hold.

**Step 4:** Now glue this flower center to the middle of your front panel (FIG. 3)



**Step 5:** Now carefully finger place the rest of the gathered strip around the center creating a flower shape you like. Once you have it positioned where you like carefully hot glue in place. (FIG. 4) Flower created and front panel done.

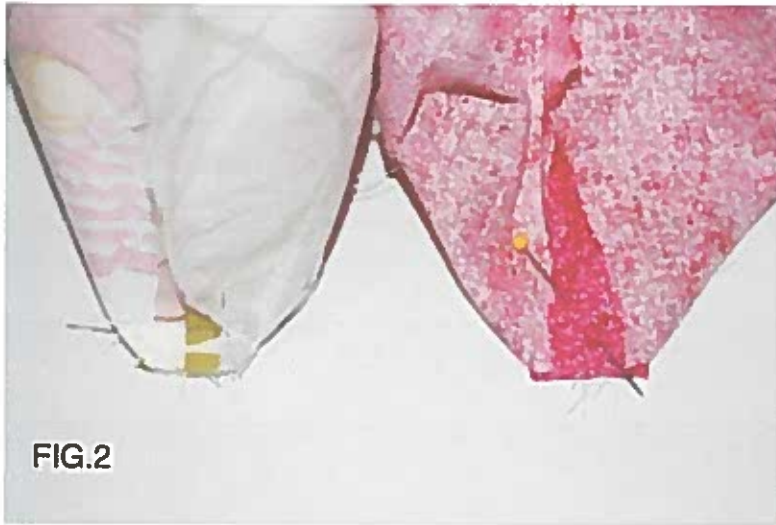
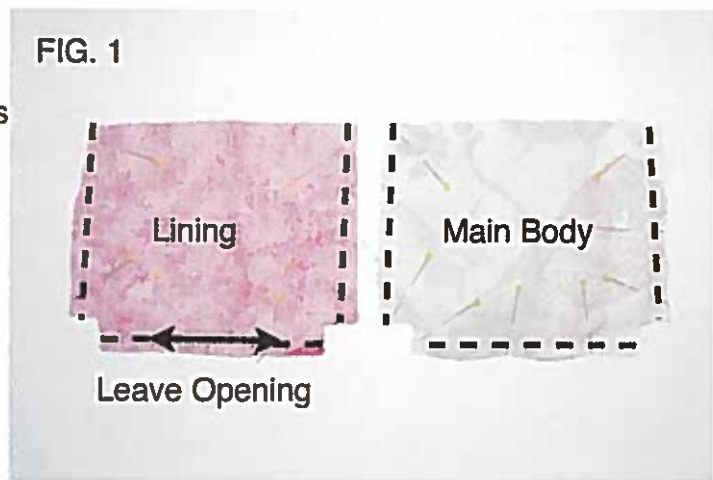


## To complete all tote styles:

Step 1: Pin main body and lining pieces right sides together. Remember to leave opening on lining for turning. (FIG. 1)

Step 2: Stitch down sides and bottom of each piece. (FIG. 1)

Step 3: Bring bottom corners together matching seams. Pin and stitch. (FIG. 2)



Step 4: Place handles on marks made. Pin and stay stitch. (FIG. 3)

Step 5: Pin down handles so they do not catch when stitching both layers together. (FIG. 4)



Step 6: Place main body inside lining with right sides together. Pin and stitch all the way around.



Step 7: Pull main body out through opening left in lining. (FIG. 6)

Step 8: Stitch lining closed with an 1/8" seam along opening. (FIG. 7)

Step 9: Top stitch 1/4" from top of bag all the way around to finish. (FIG. 8)

Step 10: Gently mold lining into the bag with your fingers to shape and your done !

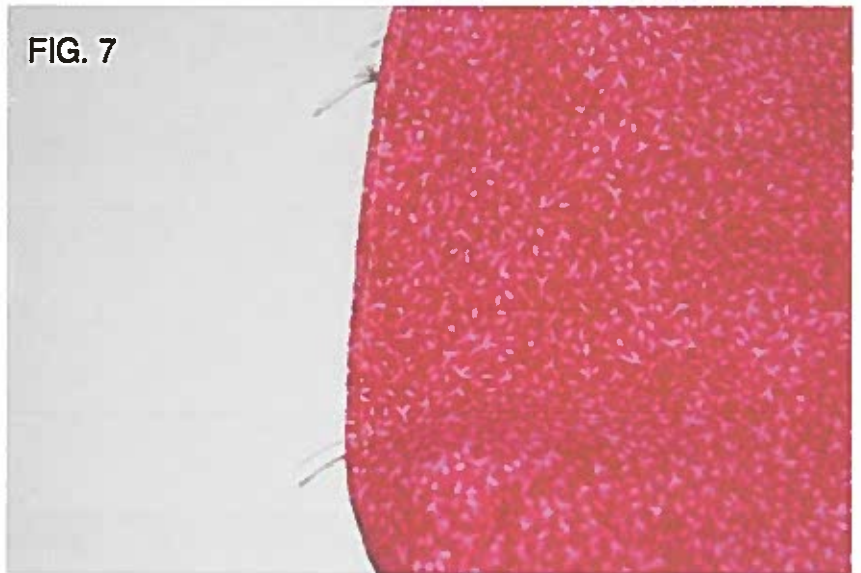
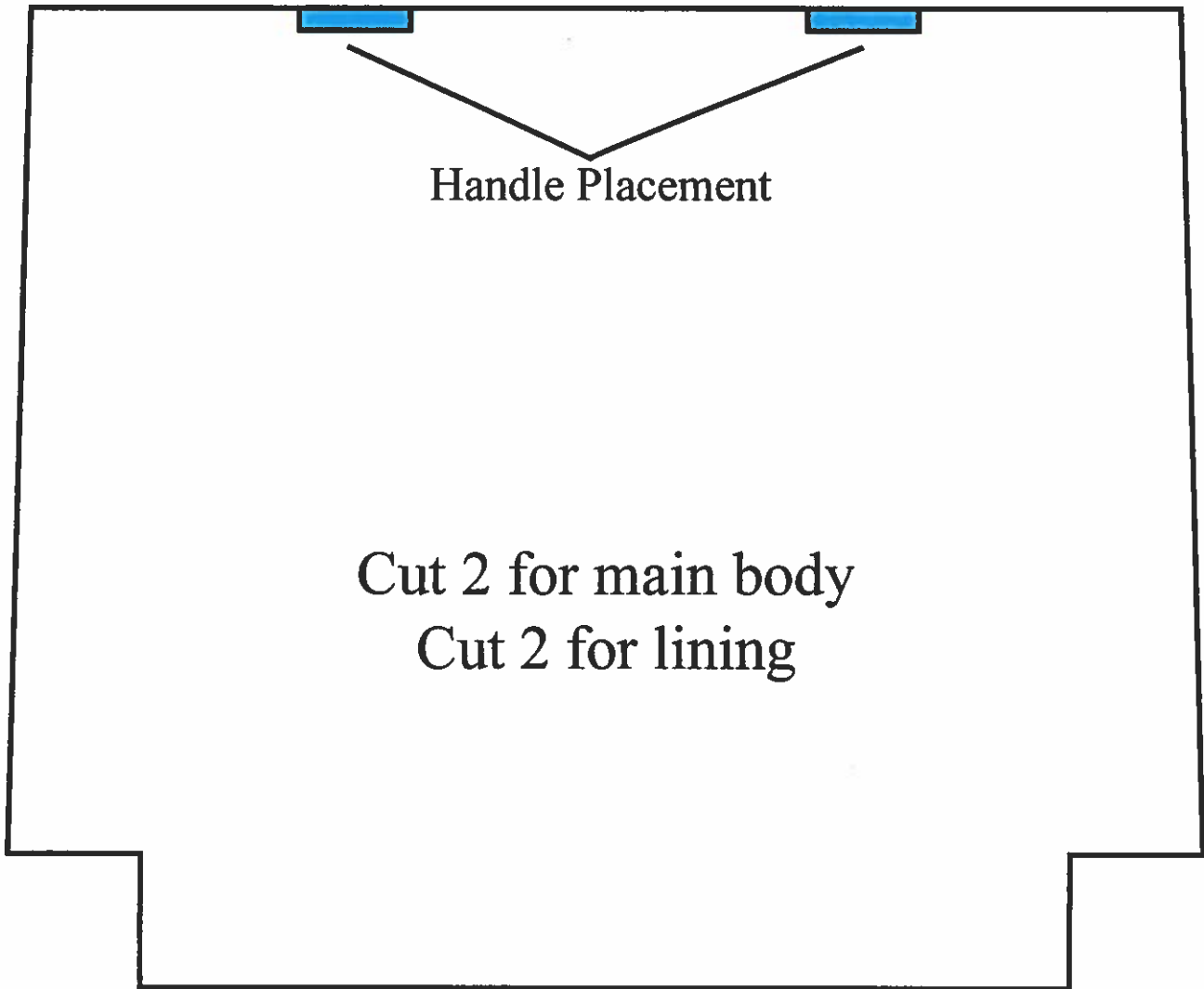
